

Shortly after collecting our guests at their accommodation in Port Elizabeth we visit the South African Marine bird Rehabilitation and Education Centre (SAMREC). SAMREC is situated in the Cape Recife Nature Reserve. This incredible facility serves not only to rehabilitate penguins and other marine birds, but also to educate the community. SAMREC can house approximately 200 penguins, and has facilities for other marine birds, seals and turtles. The centre trains and equips volunteers to assist in the rehabilitation of marine birds and animals.

We continue our tour with a drive along the wild side exploring the impressive rocky coastline before enjoying a walk along the Sacramento Trail which lays in the Schoenmakerskop-Sardinia Bay Nature Reserve. The area offers attractive seascapes, landscapes and depending on the season, some remarkable dune vegetation and wild flowers. During the months of May – November whales are often seen from this magnificent vantage point.
