The course centres around the old, white-walled, double-storey Club House. Elegantly set, it extends a warm and welcoming feeling to all.




Humewood Club Restaurant/Bar

Since 2014 the Sun Boardwalk Challenge has been played at Humewood.


Bobby Locke
